

Bench Technician – Level 3 (Permanent, full-time position - Calgary)

The bench technician - level 3 must be able to conduct in-depth diagnostics, to do repairs and major functionality tests on mechanical and electronic devices.

Main responsibilities:

- Diagnosis of the major problems of the electronic modules and mechanical equipment;
- Carry out major repairs on sophisticated modules (fit, test, calibration, replacement);
- Provide diversified technical support;
- Conduct tests with the software applications;
- Conduct compliance tests;
- Describe the behavior of a faulty module to find the source of the problem;
- Complete audit forms or enter data into the reparation system;
- Control inventory parts;
- Inform relevant personnel of abnormal consumption.
- Prepare reports on problems or shortcomings of the product;
- Develop and prepare the work process.

Job requirements:

- AEC or DEP in electronics or equivalent with minimum 5 years experience or DEC with three years experience
- Extensive knowledge of one or more of the following items: printers, servers, power supplies, POS, PC & main PCB;
- Knowledge of various diagnostic tools (multimeter, oscilloscope ...);
- Extensive knowledge of various types of welding (SMT and TH).
